At Explore Iberia we are dedicated to fostering responsible tourism practices to ensure a positive impact on the environment, local communities, and cultural heritage. Our commitment to responsible tourism is integral to our core values, and we strive to lead by example within the travel industry.

Our policy encompasses the following key principles:

1. Environmental Stewardship:

We are committed to minimizing our environmental footprint by adopting sustainable practices in our operations.

- We promote walking and nature trips, avoiding car use. Our vehicles or local taxi company are used for dropping off/picking up our travelers when no other options are available.
- We seek partnerships with suppliers who share our dedication to environmental preservation.
- All our trips are designed in a way that travelers can reach the trip start from the airport by train or bus.
- We incentive travelers to stay more than 8 days when flying to Portugal
- Our self-guided material, like route notes, is digital.
- All picnic lunches and snacks provided by us are locally grown produce and other Portuguese products, served in reusable or recyclable lunch boxes.
- We are directly involved in local conservation projects in Northern Portugal region (ex. are in charge of the maintenance and ecological recovery of a Natural Monument from Geopark Viana do Castelo), we are also partners and actively collaborate in local sustainable tourism network, CETS Alto Minho from Europarc Federation.
- We work mainly in Protected Areas, that means that all our trips respect the local rules for nature conservation.
- A large part of our trips is in protected natural areas, so when designing itineraries, we take great care to preserve the most sensitive habitats. On guided trips or tours, we work with local guides who collaborate with nature conservation organizations.
- In the last years we've promoted a small Nature festival, which seeks to disseminate and promote environmental education linked to nature, i AM nature. With free or low-cost activities. Looking to raise awareness to nature values.
- Twice per year we promote beach cleaning events and reforestation activities in burned areas.
- On every trip we make a donation of 5 euros per person to a nature conservation project or association.

2. Cultural Respect:

- We value and respect local cultures in all the regions where we operate.
- We promote authentic cultural interactions and encourage our clients to do so in a respectful manner.


